Yard Waste

Yard waste and brush can be dropped off at the transfer station (see below) as well as burned on residential property (always check with your local fire department prior to burning) however *alternatives* to burning are highly recommended. Resident Drop-off Locations

Note: Residents of each local unit of government pay for the recycle program, therefore please use only the recycle program in your town. If your local unit of government does not offer a program for recycling, voice your interest to one of your government officials.

Recycle only acceptable materials.

There is a charge every time a recycling bin is emptied. To get as much material in the bins as possible:

- PLEASE flatten all boxes
- Place materials in the bins loose (empty them from bags)

Do not leave materials on the ground. If bins are full, please return after they have been emptied. Material on the ground is unsightly and becomes litter in surrounding areas and homes.

Barry, Hope & Johnstown Township Residents - no recycling fees; dump fees determined per vehicle and items for discard.

Non-residents - additional fees may apply.

Fees: \$10/yard minimum charge > a yard/\$5. Loads not listed \$10/yard.

Stop at entrance to present driver's license.

Materials accepted:

Cardboard and Plastic

Metal - Scrap appliances, metal and tin. Appliances: \$7/unit (non-Freon) or \$25/unit containing Freon.

Tires - Auto and light-duty trucks \$5/tire, Trucks \$15/tire, Off-road \$50/tire.

Compost - \$6.50/yard. Twigs and branches must be less than 2" in diameter and no longer than 6 ft.
