Resident Drop-off Locations

Note: Residents of each local unit of government pay for the recycle program, therefore please use only the recycle program in your town. If your local unit of government does not offer a program for recycling, voice your interest to one of your government officials.

Recycle only acceptable materials.

There is a charge every time a recycling bin is emptied. To get as much material in the bins as possible:

- PLEASE flatten all boxes
- Place materials in the bins loose (empty them from bags)

Do not leave materials on the ground. If bins are full, please return after they have been emptied. Material on the ground is unsightly and becomes litter in surrounding areas and homes.

The transfer station (including recycle drop-off within the transfer station) is for residents of Orangeville Township ONLY.

As of October 1, 2018 the Orangeville Township Recycle Drop-off has relocated to the Orangeville Township Transfer Station.

Transfer Station accepts:

Scrap metal (if necessary Freon must be removed)

Recycle Drop-off accepts:

Newspaper, brown paper bags, catalogs/magazines, junk mail, non-window envelopes, fliers, glass jars and bottles, tin and aluminum cans, plastic bottles, jars and jugs, boxboard and cardboard.
