Sec. 5103. A parent or guardian of a minor or a guardian of an incapacitated individual may delegate to another person, for a period not exceeding 6 months, any of the parent's or guardian's powers regarding care, custody or property of the minor child or ward, except the power to consent to marriage or adoption of the minor ward or to release a minor ward for adoption. If a guardian for a minor or incapacitated individual delegates any power under this section, the guardian shall notify the court within 7 days after execution of the power of attorney, and provide the court the name, address, and telephone number of the attorney in fact.
