**WHEREAS**, Patricia R. Lynn began employment with the Barry County Trial Court, Family Division on January 18, 1984; and

**WHEREAS**, Ms. Lynn has served as the Caseworker for the Youth Services Bureau, a program providing diversion services to prevent youth from entering the juvenile justice system, as well as providing counseling and casework services to youth and their families involved with the Court; and

**WHEREAS**, Ms. Lynn has developed a number of programs to assist children and their families to work through conflicts; and

**WHEREAS**, Ms. Lynn has effectively worked with schools, law enforcement, and other community based social programs to provide a network of services for the youth and families of Barry County; and

**WHEREAS**, Ms. Lynn has authored "Finding the Courage to Learn How to Help Your Child," to assist parents in understanding their children's behaviors and has distributed the manual county-wide; and

**WHEREAS**, Ms. Lynn has dedicated much of her professional life to helping the youth of Barry County.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Barry County Board of Commissioners, on behalf of the citizens of Barry County, extend its appreciation for all the dedication, commitment and efforts of Patricia Lynn to the youth and families of this County and wish her continued successes in her retirement.
