| | Proposal | <p>OPERATING MILLAGE RENEWAL PROPOSAL</p> <p>This proposal will allow the school district to levy the statutory rate of 18 mills on all property, except principal residence and other property exempted by law, required for the school district to receive its revenue per pupil foundation allowance and renews millage that will expire with the 2010 tax levy.</p> <p>Shall the currently authorized millage rate limitation of 18 mills (\$18.00 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation) on the amount of taxes which may be assessed against all property, except principal residence and other property exempted by law, in Caledonia Community Schools, Kent, Allegan and Barry Counties, Michigan, be renewed for a period of 5 years, 2011 to 2015, inclusive, to provide funds for operating purposes; the estimate of the revenue the school district will collect if the millage is approved and levied in 2011 is approximately \$9,278,722 (this is a renewal of millage which will expire with the 2010 tax levy)?</p> | |

| | Proposal | <p style="text-align: center;">OPERATING MILLAGE PROPOSAL</p> <p style="text-align: center;">This proposal will enable the school district to levy the statutory rate of not to exceed 18 mills on all property, except principal residence and other property exempted by law, required for the school district to receive its revenue per pupil foundation allowance.</p> <p>Shall the limitation on the amount of taxes which may be assessed against all property, except principal residence and other property exempted by law, in Gull Lake Community Schools, Kalamazoo, Barry and Calhoun Counties, Michigan, be increased by 3.25 mills (\$3.25 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation) for a period of 4 years, 2010 to 2013, inclusive, to provide funds for operating purposes; the estimate of the revenue the school district will collect if the millage is approved and levied in 2010 is approximately \$487,450 (this millage is a partial renewal of millage that expired in 2009 and will be levied only to the extent necessary to restore millage lost as a result of the reduction required by the Michigan Constitution of 1963)?</p> | |

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| BARRY COUNTY Charlton Park Millage Renewal | PROPOSAL | <p style="text-align: center;">MILLAGE RENEWAL PROPOSITION .2259 MILL FOR OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF CHARLTON PARK</p> <p>Shall the previous voted increase in the limitation on general ad valorem taxes within Barry County, as established by Article IX, Section 6 of the Michigan Constitution, be renewed and levied at a total of .2259 mill (\$.2259 per \$1,000 of taxable value) upon all taxable real and personal property within Barry County, Michigan for a period of seven (7) years, 2010 through 2016, both inclusive, subject to reduction as provided by law?</p> <p>The purpose of this levy is to provide funding for the operation and maintenance of Charlton Park (including the Village and Museum.)</p> <p>If approved, it is estimated that the levy of .2259 mill will provide revenue of \$426,281 in the first calendar year of the levy of which \$419,517 will be disbursed to Barry County for the operation and maintenance of Charlton Park (including the Village and Museum.) It is estimated that \$6,764 will be disbursed among the City of Hastings DDA and LDFA, and Village of Middleville DDA.
